40.00	Set temp. quarter post and intersected
80.56	east boundary at 80.56 chs. and 75 lks. north of post, from which post, I run West on true line bet. secs. 13 and 24, course N.89°28'W.
13.50	Enter prairie.
40.28	Set quarter sec. post around which a mound was raised as per instructions.
80.56	To cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24. Land mostly level on west 3/4 of line, east 1/4, hilly, land 2nd rate. Timber, a few scattering oak and laurel trees on the east part of the line.

80.00	Set post, cor to secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, from which A B Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S.15°E., 154 lks. dist. A B Oak, 18 ins. diam., bears S.69°W., 228 lks. dist. A Maple, 15 ins. diam.. bears N.18°W., 97 lks. dist. An Alder, 17 ins. diam.. bears N.7°E., 69 lks. dist.
