

## West Boundary of T. 30 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

CHAINS

Land on NW slope of mountain mountainous.

Soil rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.

Timber dense, forest of Fir, Cedar, Laurel, and Yew.

Thick undergrowth of Fir and Laurel with Hazel and  
Vine Maple.

September 18, 1882.

North between secs. 13 and 18.

Va. 19\* 30' E.

Descend.

- 18.50 A creek, 12 lks. wide, course E.
- 19.00 New wagon road, course E and W. Moderate ascent.
- 40.00 Set a Laurel post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq. 18 ins. in  
the ground for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on the  
W. side from which
- A Fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S.44\*E., 24 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. B. T.
- A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears S.28\*W., 23 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. B. T.
- 56.00 Top of ridge, course E. Descend.
- 58.25 A spring branch 1 lk. wide, course NE.
- 74.00 Ft. of hill, enter burned clearing, course E and W.
- 78.20 A creek 15 lks. wide, course E.
- 79.00 A wagon road, course E and W. Enter timber.
- 80.00 Set a Fir post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 20 ins. in the ground  
for the cor. to secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18. Marked T. 30  
S., R. 7 W. S. 7 on the NE face.
- S. 18 on the SW face and S .2 on the NW face, also  
with 4 notches on the S. and two notches on the N.  
angles of same, and from which
- A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.56\*E., 22 lks. dist.  
Marked T. 30 S., R. 7 W S 7. B. T.
- A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.56\*E., 27 lks. dist.  
Marked T. 30 S., R. 7 W S. 18. B. T.
