

## Retracement and Survey Portion South Edy., T. 30 S., R. 7W.

## CHAINS

From the cor. of Tps. 30 and 31 S., Rs. 7 and 8 W.  
East, retracing the line bet. secs. 6 and 31.  
Descend steep SE. slope.

- 2.15 Top of bluff, 150 ft. high.  
5.25 rt. of bluff.  
19.85 Top of spur, slopes Se., descend.  
21.90 Ravine, course S., ascend.  
23.20 Top of spur, slopes S., descend.  
24.75 Ravine, course S., ascend.  
25.75 Top of spur, slopes S., descend.  
31.65 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE., ascend.  
33.75 Top of spur, slopes NE., descend.  
36.15 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N., ascend.  
36.90 Trail, bears N. and S.  
38.10 Fall 61 lks. S. of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., located by refer-

ence to the bearing trees. At the exact cor. point  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor, with brass cap marked

 $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6

from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 76 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 P T (New B.T.)

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.41°W., 31 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6 B T (New B.T.)

An alder, 24 ins. dian., bears N.25°E., 13 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T (Old B.T.)

A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears S.48°E., 28 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 6 B T (Old B.T.)

The true course and length of this line is N.89°05'E.,  
38.11 chs.

I continue my retracement east from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.,  
counting distance from the up. cor.
