Timber, yellow pine, fir, white oak, black oak and
live oak.

Along SE. slope, over conglomerate bluffs.

3.88 Point for cor. of secs. 4 and 5, T. 31 S., R. 7 W. falls

6.80 Deep rift in bluffs, course S.
