Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of sec. 5 only, with brass cap marked

A black oak, 7 ins. diam., bears S.38°E., 9 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 5 B T.

A black oak, 24 ins. diam., bears S.66°W., 40 lks. dist. Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

44.25 Trail, bears NE, and SW., descend gentle w. slope.

54.00 Trail, bears N. and S.

55.15 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S.80°W.

65.45 Bend in same creek, course S.85°W., ascend.

69.50 Top of ascent on SW. slope., descend W. slope.

71.90 Descend bluff, 25 ft. high.

75.00 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S., ascend.

76.72 A point south of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. secs. 31 and 32.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.70°W., 12 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  30 S R 7 W S 31 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, solid conglomerate rock and rocky red clay, 3rd. and 4th rate.

Timber, yellow pine, fir, live oak and black oak.
