CHAINS	North between Secs. 25 & 26. Va. 19*East.
9.00	Along East slope of Mountain.
40.00	Set a Laurel post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.23*E., 32 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.64*W., 18 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
44.00	Descend along steep East slope.
80.00	Set an Alder post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 20 ins. in the ground for the corner to Secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26, marked T 30 S R 8 W S 24 on the NE. face, S 25 on the SE. face S 26 on the SW. face and S 23 on the NW. face. Also 2 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the E. angles of same, and from which A Yew, 12 ins. diam., bears N.67*E., 32 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 24 B T A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.18*E., 33 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 25 B T A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 31 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 26 B T An Alder, 4 ins. diam., bears N.42*W., 18 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 23 B T Land, mountainous. Soil, 3d rate. Timber: Dense forest of fir, pine, laurel and cedar. Thick undergrowth of same kinds of wood, with live oak, alder and hazel.
