CHAINS 4.50	Top of Spur, course N. Descend.
9.50	Dry Ravine, course NE. Ascend along steep N. slope.
10.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
43.00	Steep Ascent.
80.26	Intersect East Boundary of Township 142 lks. South of Cor. to Secs. 19, 24, 25 & 30, which is a fir 16 ins. diam., marked T 30 S R 7 W S 19 on NE. side, S 30 on the SE. side, R 8 W S 25 on the SW. side, S 24 on the NW. Also 2 notches on the south side and 4 notches on the north sides of the same, and from which A Fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N.48°E., 13 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 7 W S 19 B T A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.58°E., 40 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 7 W S 30 B T A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.80°W., 37 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 25 B T A Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N.20°W., 19 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 24 B T Thence I run S.88°59' West on a True Line bet. Secs. 24 & 25. Va.19°30' East.
40.13-	Set a Fir post 4 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 20 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on the N. side, and from which A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.80°E., 17 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.9°W., 36 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
80.26	To the Corner to Secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26. Land, mountainous. Soil, 3d rate. Timber: Dense forest of fir, cedar and laurel. Thick undergrowth of fir and cedar with vine maple and alder.
