Set a Cedar post 4 ft. long 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for the Cor. to Secs. 26, 27, 34 & 35, marked T 30 S R 8 W S 26 on NE., S 35 on SE., S 34 on SW., and S 27 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, from which

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.50*E., 48 lks. dist.
