60.00	Spur, course S.60*E. Descend.
75.20	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S.60*E.
79.90	Intersect N. & S. line 279 lks. S. of the Corner to Secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24. Thence I run S.88* West on a True Line between Secs. 14 & 23. With same Var.
39.95	Set a Laurel post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face, from which A Laurel, 4 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 8 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 15 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
79.90	The Corner to Secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23. Land, mountainous. Soil, 3d rate. Timber: Densely covered with forests of fir, laurel and cedar.
	North between Secs. 14 & 15. Va. 19*East. Descend along steep, broken NW. Slope.
40.00	Set a Fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.65*W., 70 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S.78*E., 36 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
64.25	Creek, 10 lks. wide, course NE. Thence ascend along very steep SE. Slope.
