

Subdivisions of T. 30 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS	Thence along very Steep North side hill.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
47.00	Same Ridge, course NE. Descend.
79.80	Intersect N. & S. line 166 lks. S. of the Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 11 & 12. Thence I run S.88*49' West on a True Line bet. Secs. 2 & 11. With same Var.
39.90	Set a Stone 12x12x10 ins., 8 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N., face, from which A Fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S.38*E., 18 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.28*W., 39 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
79.80	The Corner to Secs. 2, 3, 10 & 11. Land, mountainous. Soil, 3d rate. Timber, densely covered with forests. Chiefly fir, with some laurel, cedar and pine. Undergrowth: Same kinds of wood, fir, laurel, cedar and pine.
	North on a Random Line bet. Secs. 2 & 3. Va. 19*East.
	Along Steep E. Slope of mountain.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
77.54	Intersect north boundary of Township 48 lks. West of established cor. to Secs. 2 & 3, which is a Cedar post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. triangular, firmly set in the ground, and marked T 29 S R 8 W S 34 on N. side, T 30 S R 8 W S 2 on the SE. side, S 3 on the SW side. Also 2 notches on the East and 4 notches on the West angles of same, and from which A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.42*E., 32 lks. dist. Marked T 29 S R 8 W S 34 B T A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears S.54*E., 24 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 2 B T
