51.25	Top of Spur, course North. Descend.
53.70	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. Ascend.
69.50	Top of Hill. Thence along North Slope.
80.36	Intersect N. & S. line 283 lks. South of the Cor. to Secs. 14, 15, 22 & 23. Thence I run S.87*59' West on a True Line bet. Secs. 15 & 22. With same Var.

40.00	Set a Laurel post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on West face, from which A Laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears N.65*E., 48 lks. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
