79.83	The Corner to Secs. 28, 29, 32 & 33. Land, NW. Slope of mountain. Timber: Densely covered with forests of Fir, laurel, cedar and pine. Undergrowth of laurel, cedar and fir.
	North between Secs. 28 & 29. <span style="float: right;">Va. 19* East.</span> Over Rolling ground.
40.00	Set a Fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on West face, from which A Chincapin, 5 ins. diam., bears S.46*W., 40 lks. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.40*E., 8 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
47.00	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW.
64.00	Steep Descent.
73.00	Creek, 8 lks. wide, course NW. Steep Ascent
80.00	Set a Stone 20x16x6 ins. in a mound of stone built on a large rock for the Cor. to Secs. 20, 21, 28 & 29, marked with 2 notches on South and 4 notches on East edges, from which A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.80*E., 44 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 21 B T A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.74*E., 35 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 28 B T A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.58*W., 54 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 29 B T A Live Oak, 10 ins. diam, bears N.86*W., 40 lks. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 20 B T
