Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T An Oak, 8 ins. diam., bears S.54*E., 13 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T</p>

76.00	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course W. Ascend.
80.00	Set a Laurel post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for the Cor. to Secs. 16, 17, 20 & 21, marked T 30 S R 8 W S 16 on NE., S 21 on SE., S 20 on SW., and S 17 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on South and 4 notches on East edges, from which <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A Laurel, 16 ins. diam., bears N.14*E., 93 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 16 B T A Pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S.37*E., 100 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 21 B T A Pine, 24 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 76 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 20 B T A Pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N.17*W., 88 lks. dist. Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 17 B T</p>
