 cedar and laurel.  
 Undergrowth of fir, cedar and pine.  
 November 9th, 1882.

East on a Random Line bet. Secs. 29 & 32.  
 Va. 19\* East.

2.00 Summit of Ridge, course S.75\*E.  
 Moderate Descent along North slope.  
 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor.  
 43.85 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.  
 79.55 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.  
 79.90 Intersect N. & S. line 287 lks. South of the Cor. to  
 Secs. 28, 29, 32 & 33.

39.95 Set a Cedar post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in the

 A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.28\*E., 16 lks. dist.  
 Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T  
 A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.45\*W., 5 lks. dist.  
 Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

79.90 The Corner to Secs. 29, 30, 31 & 32.  
 Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, 3d rate.  
 Timber: Densely covered with forests of fir, cedar,  
 laurel and pine.  
 Undergrowth of same kinds of woods.

West on a Random Line between Secs. 30 & 31.  
 Va. 19\* East.  
 Descend along a SW. Slope.
