CHAINS

- 33.50 Descend Bluff, course S.60*E.
Thence along very steep rocky South side hill.
- 40.00 Set. temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
- 55.00 Ascend.
- 74.65 Top of high point of Rock. Descend Bluff. Thence
down a very steep Descent.
- 88.84 Intersect West Boundary of Township 220 lks. North of
the Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 & 36, which is a post 4 in.
sq., firmly set in the ground, and marked T 30 SR 8 W S
30 on the NE., S 31 on SE., R 9 W S 36 on SW., and S 25
on NW. faces, with 1 notch on South and 5 notches on
North edges, from which
- A Pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 87 lks. dist.
Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 30 B T
- An Oak, 5 ins. diam., bears S.10*E., 9 lks. dist.
Marked T 30 S R 8 W S 31 B T
- A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.1 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 540 lks. dist.
Marked T 30 S R 9 W S 36 B T
- A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.47*W., 37 lks. dist.
Marked T 30 S R 9 W S 25 B T
- Thence I run
N.88*26' East on a True Line between Secs. 30 & 31.
With same Var.
- 48.84 Set a Stone 14x9x5 ins., 9 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.
Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on North face, from which
- An Oak, 9 ins. diam., bears N.62*W., 44 lks. dist.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
- A Live Oak, 15 ins. diam., bears S.22*W., 34 lks.
Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
- 88.84 The Corner to Secs. 29, 30, 31 & 32.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, 3d rate.
Timber: Densely covered with forests of fir, laurel,
cedar, pine and oak.
Thick undergrowth of same kinds of wood.
