WM on W. face, with 6 notches on the N, S, E and W. edges.

from which

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.10°E., 58 lks. dist.,
mkd. W.M. T 31 S R 1 E S 31 B T.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S.45°E., 63 lks. dist.,
mkd. W.M. T 32 S R 1 E S 6 B T.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S.81°W., 78 lks. dist.,
mkd. W.M. T 32 S R 1 W S 1 B T.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.32°W., 23 lks. dist.,
mkd. W.M. T 32 S R 1 W S 36 B T.

Set a basalt stone, 35x15x5 ins. 24 ins. in the ground on top of the Umpqua divide, for closing cor. to secs. 1 and 36, mkd. C.C. on W. face, with 6 notches on N, S and W edges.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.41°E., 28 lks. dist.,
mkd. C C T 31 S R 1 E S 31 B T.

A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.30°W., 2 lks. dist.,
mkd. C C T 32 S R 1 W S 1 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.74°W., 42 lks. dist.,
mkd. C C T 31 S R 1 W S 36 B T.

Land, high and mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Densely covered with forests of fir and cedar, 109.00 chs. and thick undergrowth of fir, matherone, arrowwood, and chinquapin, 117.00 chs.
