

Resurvey of North Boundary of T. 32 S., R. 1 W.,
same Deputy and Contract.

CHAINS

Note:

As this last close is not in limits with my close in running North on W. bdy. of T. 32 S., R. 1 W., I proceed to resurvey the N. bdy. of the T. and establish sec. cors. on the same at every 80.00 chs. for T. 32 S., R. 1 W.

I begin at my closing cor. on the Meridian and run West, on a true line on N. bdy. of Sec. 1.

Va. 20*E.

- 22.00 Descend from Umpqua divide and ridge, bears NE. and SW.
- 50.35 A point 700 ft. below top of Umpqua Divide and a Ravine, course NW.
- 57.65 Ravine, course N.30*W., and ascend 500 ft. to
- 65.25 Top of ridge, bears N.30*W., and S.30*E., and descend 300 ft. to
- 75.50 Enter Glade and leave timber, bears N. and S.
- 77.00 To my 1/4 sec. cor. on S. bdy. of sec. 36, established in running East, which is a basalt stone, 18x10x6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground, mkd. 1/4 on N. face, from which
 - A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.11*E., 12 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S B T.
 - A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.32*E., 22 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S B T.
- 80.00 A point, 3.00 chs. W. of 1/4 sec. cor. and set a basalt stone, 18x10x6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 1 and 2, mkd. with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges.
 - from which
 - A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.3*W., 45 lks. dist., mkd. T 31 S R 1 W S 36 B T.
