80.00 A point 3.00 chs. W. of 1/4 sec. cor. and set a fir post  
4 ft. long 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for cor.  
to secs. 2 and 3, mkd. T 32 S R 1 W on S face, S 2 on  
E. and S 3 on W. faces, with 2 notches on E. and 4  
notches on W. faces.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.45\*W., 11 lks. dist.,

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.5\*W., 29 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T 31 S R 1 W S 35 B T.
