Retracement of Willamette Meridian through T. 31 S.

I commence at the cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 S., R. 1 E.,
only, which is a basalt stone, firmly set, 6x14x6 ins.
above ground, marked with 6 notches on N., S., E., and
W. edges; from which

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.10°E., 58 lks. dist.,
mkd. W M T 31 S R 1 E S 31 B T. (Old B T.)

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S.47°E., 63 lks. dist.,
mkd. W M T 32 S R 1 E S 6 B T. (Old B T)

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S.81°W., 78 lks. dist.,
mkd. W M T 32 S R 1 W S 1 B T. (Old B T.)

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.32°W., 23 lks. dist.,
mkd. W M T 31 S R 1 W S 36 B T. (Old B T.)

I obliterate the marks on the bearing trees referring
to Tps. 31 and 32 S., R. 1 W., and re-mark the stone

31 S. on N.,

32 S. on S., and

1 E. on E. face.

Thence

North, retracing W. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

Asc. 890 ft. to closing cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 S., R. 1 W.,
over S. slope.

0.76 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.

25.33 California-Oregon Power Co. road, bears E. and W.
