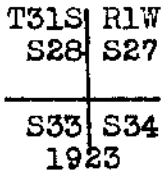

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.59*W., 34 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 31 S R 1 W S 33 B T. (New B.T)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.44*W., 31 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 31 S R 1 W S 28 B T. (Old B.T.)

The old SW. bearing tree is dead.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 2nd rate.

Timber, fir.

Undergrowth, vine maple.

N.0*07*W., on a true line, bet. secs. 27 and 28.
