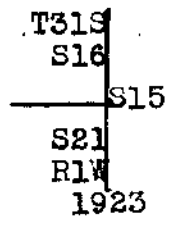
Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines

I now change this cor. to refer to secs. 16 and 21 only,
and obliterate the marks on the bearing trees referring
to secs. 15 and 22.

In place of the decayed post

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 16 and 21 only, with
brass cap marked

Soil, rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and hazel.

N.0*12'E., bet. secs. 15 and 16.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

Desc. 387 ft. over NW. slope.

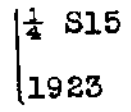
24.50 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 163 ft. to
