Subdivision of T. 31 S., R. 1 W.

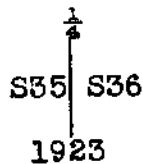
From the cor. of secs. 35 and 36 only, on the S. bdy of

N.0°01'W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense  
undergrowth.

- 1.85 Ravine, course W.; asc. 160 ft. over S. slope.
- 9.21 Trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 10.20 Claifornia-Oregon Power Co. transmission line, bears E.  
and W.
- 13.50 Sled road, bears E. and W.  
Desc. steep NW. slope, 690 ft. to
- 27.75 Top of bluff, 75 ft. high, bears NW. and SE.
- 31.77 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 162 ft. over steep  
SW. slope. to 1/4 sec. cor.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in  
the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked
