48.99 Traverse point, impassable bluffs on line; thence on  
traverse line

N.81°E., 8.41 chs. ascending break in bluff.

N.52°W., 8.52 chs. along top of bluff.

West, 1.60 chs. and regain line at

55.56 Top of bluffs, 340 ft. above traverse point; continue  
ascent.

69.00 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 426 ft. to sec. cor.

70.82 Traverse point; line descends over series of impassable
