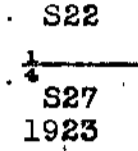

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.48*E., 12 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 22 B T.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S.39*W., 16 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 27 B T.

43.05, Spring branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 817 ft. to sec. cor., over SW. slope.

51.10 Rim rock, 20 ft. high bears N. and S.

66.92 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW.

82.37 The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, fir and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and hazel.

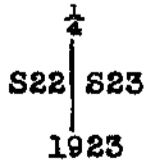
N.0*02'W., bet. secs. 22 and 23.
