CHAINS

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.33*W., 21 lks. dist.,
mkd. 1/4 S 4 B T.

A yew, 8 ins. diam., bears N.45*W., 43 lks. dist.,
mkd. 1/4 S 4 B T.

Desc. 325 ft. to closing cor.

42.81 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.

59.54 Enter openings, bears NE. and SW.

68.27 Leave openings; enter timber, bears NE. and SW.

80.46 Intersect S. bdy. of T. 30 S., R. 1 W., 3.29 chs. N.89*
34*W. of the cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, hereinbefore
described.

At the point of intersection

Set closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, hereinbefore described.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, fir and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and hazel.

mkd. T 32 S R 1 W S 6 B T. (Old B T.)

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears N.5*W., 20 lks. dist.,
mkd. T 31 S R 1 W S 31 B T. (Old B T.)

The old bearing tree in sec. 32 is dead and fallen.

Obliterate the marks on the bearing tree referring to
sec. 6 and at exact cor. point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 31 and 32 only, with
