

Retracement of Portion of West Boundary

CHAINS

North, retracing bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

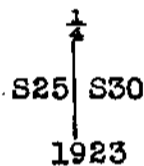
Desc. 417 ft. over NE. slope.

14.20 Bluff, 150 ft. high, faces N.

24.70 Creek, 15 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 156 ft. over SE. slope.

40.46 Intersect the point for the 1/4 sec. cor., which I locate by measurement from the bearing trees.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A laurel, 18 ins. diam., bears N.65\*E., 28 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 30 B T. (Old B T.)

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N.51\*W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 25 B.T. (Old B T.)

Asc. 152 ft. to

66.09 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 355 ft. over NW. slope.

81.28 Fall 20 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, located by reference to the SE. bearing tree; no other evidence.

At exact cor. point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, with brass cap marked
