CHAINS

The bearing and length of the north half mile is S.0°10' E., 41.60 chs. and of the south half mile is S.0°13'E., 40.59 chs.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, fir, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple.

South, retracing bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

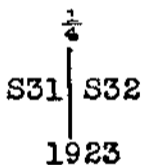
Asc. 345 ft. over general NE. slope.

15.40 Draw, course NE.

25.21. Desc. 210 ft. over SE. slope.

40.63 Fall 10 lks. W. of the point for the 1/4 sec. cor., which I locate by reference to the original bearing trees.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S.85°E., 12 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 32 B T. (Old B T.)

A live oak, 6 ins. diam., bears N.55°W., 32 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 31 B T. (Old B T.)
