Timber, fir, cedar, pine and madrona,

Undergrowth, vine maple and huckleberry.

From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

West, retracing bet. secs. 30 and 31.

Asc. 250 ft. over NE. slope.

31.64 Top of ridge, bears N. and S.

Fall 17 lks. N. of the witness cor. to the 1/4 sec. cor. which is a fir, 15 ins. diam., with marks grown over; from which

A dead laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears S.40°E., 20 lks. dist., mkd. W C 1/4 S B T. (Old B T.)

A dead laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.35°W., 36 lks. dist., mkd. W C 1/4 S B T. (Old B T.)

The bearing of the line from the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, to the witness cor. to the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 30 and 31 is S.89°42'W,

From the witness cor. to the 1/4 sec. cor.,

S.89°42'W., on a true line.
