40.00	Set a basalt stone, 24x12x4 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on the N face from which A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.5°E., 38 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 35 B T A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.4 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 20 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 35 B T
45.25	Foot of mountain 300 ft. below top of divide, bears N & S Over level swampy land
53.15	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.10°W.
61.00	Leave bottom bears N & S and ascend
73.50	Ridge point, 200 ft. above Creek, descends toward the North; Descend
80.00	Set an ironstone 24x10x4 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 35 & 36 marked with one notch on the E and 5 notches on W edges from which A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.67 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 42 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 2 W S 36 B T A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.63°W., 43 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 2 W S 35 B T Land level and mountainous Soil, sandy loam and gravelly; 1st. & 3rd. rate Timber, Fir, Pine, with some Hemlock Undergrowth, vinemaple & laurel Mountainous and heavily timbered lands 80.00 chs.
