

Retracement of South Boundary of T. 31 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

37.62 The cor. of secs. 4 & 5 T. 32 S., R. 2 W., which is a basalt stone, 6x8x5 ins. above ground firmly set and marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general bears South 10 lks. dist.

39.07 The Qr. sec. cor. on South Bdy., sec. 33., which is an ironstone 6x10x5 ins. above ground firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, bears South 10 lks. dist.

The course of this line is S.89*49'W.
Commencing at the qr. sec. cor. I retrace S.89*58'W., on S. Bdy., sec. 33.

37.87 The cor. of secs. 32 & 33, which is a washed stone 6x8x8 ins. above ground firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, bears South 22 lks. dist.
The course of this line is S.89*40'W.

41.90 The cor. of secs. 5 & 6, T. 32 S., R. 2 W., which is an ironstone 6x8x4 ins. above ground firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

43.50 The Qr. sec. cor. on South bdy. of sec. 32, which is a basalt stone, 4x10x5 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

Commencing at the qr. sec. cor., I retrace S.89*58'W., on South bdy., sec. 32.

38.83 The cor. of secs. 31 & 32, which is a basalt stone 6x10x4 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
