A Madrone, 12 ins. diam., bears S.85*W., 50 lks. dist., Marked T 31 S R 2 W S 33 B T

A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.68*W., 63 lks. dist.

Land Mountainous

Soil Clay and stony, 2nd. & 3rd. rate

23.00 Blazed trail bears N & S

24.25 A Fir, 36 ins. diam., marked with 2 notches on E & W sides on ridge bears NW & SE

25.00 Trail bears NW & SE

Along S slope

40.00 No stones obtainable

Set a Fir Post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S 28 on N and 33 on S face from which
