48.50 Bottom of hollow

62.15 Line passes bet. two Firs, 48 ins. diam.

66.50 Divide bet. Granite & Callahan Creeks bears NE & SW
 Trail to Cow Creek bears NE & S W
 Descend NW slope

71.00 A spring bears N 100 lks. dist.

76.25 Ridge point descending NW

Land Mountainous

Soil, granite, 3rd. rate

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Madrone, Pine: Undergrowth, Madrone Fir, Hazel, Lilac.
