A Fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.42½\*W., 25 lks. dist.,

Marked T 31 S R 2 W S 17 B T

At the temp. closing cor. set June 20 on the S boundary  
 of sec. 16, 3.17 chs. <sup>N.</sup> of the closing cor. of secs. 17 &  
 20 and 2.83 chs. E of the old cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20  
 & 21. I reestablish closing cor. of secs. 17 & 21 as  
 follows

No stones obtainable

Set a Fir Post 3 ft. long 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the  
 ground for closing cor. of secs. 17 & 21 marked S 21 on  
 East

CC T 31 S R 2 W on S and

S 17 on W face with 4 grooves on E face from which

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.15\*E., 27 lks. dist.,

Marked T 31 S R 2 W S 21 B T

A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.6\*W., 71 lks. dist.,

Marked T 31 S R 2 W S 17 B T

The old cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 & 21 is partially  
 obliterated the post being decayed and the bearing trees  
 overgrown

I reestablish this cor. in its original position as the  
 SW cor. of sec. 16 only as follows

Set a Granite stone 18x8x8 ins. 12 ins. in the ground  
 for SW cor. of sec. 16 marked with 4 notches on E edge  
 from which

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.35½\*E., 60 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 2 W S 16 B T

Destroy marks on bearing trees referring to secs. 17, 20  
 & 21

From the closing cor. of secs. 17 & 20 I run  
 N.89\*56'W., on a true line bet. secs. 17 & 20

Over Mountainous land heavily timbered and covered with  
 dense undergrowth
