80.00 Set a quartz stone, 18 x 10 x 9 ins., 12 ins. in the  
 ground, for cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 30 S., R. 2 W.,  
 marked with:

5 notches on E., and  
 1 notch on W. edge;

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 23°E., 189 lks.  
 dist., marked: T 30 S R 2 W S 32 BT.

A madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 47 1/2°W., 53 lks.  
 dist., marked: T 30 S R 2 W S 31 BT.
