The S & W boundaries of sec. 25; the S boundaries of secs. 22 & 23; the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S boundary of sec. 21; The E boundary of sec. 22; the S & W boundaries os sec. 16; the E & N and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the W boundaries of sec. 9; the E and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the West boundaries of sec. 4; were run to account for discrepancies in closing and to locate and reestablish the nearly obliterated cors. which were established 50 yrs. ago.

Over Mountainous land he vily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth

Descend NW slope

17.95 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NE

Ascend SW slope

33.00 Rock bluff 40 ft. high

40.60 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. nearly obliterated

The only remaining evidence is one bearing tree. I reestablish the cor. in its original position as follows

Set a basalt stone 15x8x7 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for

$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N face from which

A Madrone, 20 ins. diam., bears N.55*E., 12 lks. dist., Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 B T

A Madrone, 8 ins. diam., bears S.23*E., 22 lks. dist., Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 B T

The course of this line is West and the distance is 40.60 chs.

Commencing at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. I run
