CHAINS

28.53	A pine, 18 ins. diam., on line marked with 2 notches on N and S sides; descend.	-50
34.35	A spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course SW; ascend. April 8, 1894. Leave timber; enter dense madrone brush on very rocky land.	+175
40.00	Set a stone, 18x8x8 ins. 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face; from which A laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.32*W., 49 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears S.29*E., 82 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.	
42.00	Descend.	-500
43.65	A cedar, 40 ins. diam., on line marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.	
47.50	Enter heavy timber.	
58.25	A fir, 36 ins. diam., on line marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.	
79.35	A fir, 16 ins. diam., on line marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.	
80.00	Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, marked T 31 S S 13 on NE., R 3 W S 24 on SE., S 23 on SW., and S 14 on NW., faces, with 1 notch on E and 3 notches on S edges; from which A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.65 $\frac{1}{4}$ *E., 28 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 3 W S 13 B T. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.58 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 19 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 3 W S 24 B T. A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.31 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 3 W S 23 B T. A laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.66-3/4*W., 37 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 3 W S 14 B T.
