CHAINS

Land, mountainous. 102.30 chs.

Soil, 3d rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, laurel, cedar, chinquapin and maple. 97.30 chs.

Dense undergrowth of laurel, chinquapin, hazel, madrone, elkbrush, thimbleberry, rhododendron, arrow-wood, hemlock, cedar and fir. 102.30.

May 7, 1894.

55 miles, 11 chs. and 1 lk. of the subdivision lines run over mountainous land, through heavy timber or dense undergrowth.

26 chs. and 7 lks. of the connecting lines, run over mountainous land, through heavy timber or dense undergrowth.

4 miles, 74 chs. and 59 lks. retraced over mountainous land, through heavy timber or dense undergrowth.

General Description

This township is mountainous. It is covered with heavy timber of fir, laurel, maple, cedar, chinquapin and pine. There is some good land in the South part. It is well watered by mountain streams of pure, clear water.
