

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

## West Boundary of T. 31 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS	
59.00	To a ravine, course W and commence steep rocky ascent of mountain.
59.00	East about 20 chs. to a very precipitous mountain, course N and S.
62.00	To foot of a basalt ledge.
64.75	Top of ledge, course E and W.
70.75	Summit of a sharp ridge sloping to the W., course E and W., and commence steep descent.
70.75	The Oregon and California road, is about a half a mile W of this point, in a deep canyon, course nearly N and S.
78.50	To head of a ravine, course W and commence ascent on a NW slope.
80.00	A Laurel, 4 ins. diam., for cor., of secs. 7, 18, 12 and 13, from which A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.15*W., 26 lks. A laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 60 lks. A laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears N.45*E., 48 lks. Land, very steep, rugged rocky mountains. Timber, fir, laurel, maple, etc. Undergrowth, laurel, hazel, live oak, manzanita, etc. thick.
	South, on West boundary of Sec. 18. Va.18*00'E.
3.75	To foot of perpendicular ledge 30 ft. high.
11.50	Top of a high rocky ridge, course S.70*W., and N.60*E., curving to the Northward.
11.50	Commence steep rocky descent.
13.15	Fir, 40 ins. diam.
36.25	To a stream, 2 lks. wide, course S.20*W.
40.00	Set $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post, on W point of a ridge, from which A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.73*W., 15 lks. A laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears S.71*E., 41 lks.
