I, therefore, destroy the marks on the 2 fir witness trees E of the old cor. in T 31 S., R. 4 W., and remove post cor. which is greatly decayed, and set a stone, 14x8x7 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 25 and 36, marked with 5 notches on N and 1 notch on S faces.</p> <p>Thence I run</p> <p>East, on a true line, bet. secs. 30 and 31.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Va.18-3/4*E.</p> <p>Descend.</p>	+175
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
