N of cor. to secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, which is a post, greatly decayed, with marks obliterated, from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 30 ins. diam., (36 ins. now) bears N.21*E., 23 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 18 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S.26*E., 8 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 19 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.58*W., 20 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 5 W S 24 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.81*W., 58 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 5 W S 13 B T.</p> <p>As this is a cor. to secs. 13 and 24 only, I destroy the marks on the 2 fir trees E of the cor. in T 31 S., R. 4 W., and remove this decayed post and set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 13 and 24, marked T 31 S S 24 on SW., and R 5 W S 24 on NW faces, with 3 notches on N and 3 notches on S edges.</p> <p>At point of intersection, set a stone, 14x10x5 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. to secs. 18 and 19, marked C C on E face, with 3 notches on N and S faces; from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.65*E., 100 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 18 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears S.54*E., 62 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 19 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.14½*W., 33 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W C C S 18 and 19 B T.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. 78.92 chs.</p> <p>Soil, 3d rate.</p>
