CHAINS

The other witness trees are destroyed by fire.
 I remove this decayed cor. and set a stone, 18x8x6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 12 and 13, marked with 2 notches on N and 4 notches S edges and raised mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, 3 ft. S of cor.

No live trees in limits in T 31 S., R. 5 W; pits impracticable.

I measure N 6.75 chs. to temp. post. As this closing is not within the prescribed limits, I begin at this cor. to secs. 12 and 13 and run

South, on a blank line, bet. secs. 13 and 18.

Va. 18¼*E.

Ascend steeply on very stony land in dense undergrowth.

 A fir, 8 ins. diam., (12 ins. now) bears S.73*W., 15 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.
 Fire has destroyed the laurel in Sec. 18. I therefore mark a laurel, 7 ins. diam., which bears N.34*E., 29 lks. dist., ¼ S B T.
 From this cor. temp. post, bears S.4*W., 53 lks. dist.,
