 Heavily timbered with fir, laurel, cedar, chinquapin  
 and maple . S 55.00 chs.  
 Dense undergrowth of laurel, madrone, vine maple, arrow-  
 wood and rhododendron. 79.30 chs.

At point of intersection  
 Set a stone, 14x12x4 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for  
 closing cor. to secs. 7 and 18, marked C C on E face,  
 with 2 notches on N and 4 notches on S faces; from  
 which

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N.29½°E., 139½ lks.  
 dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 7 B T.

A fir, 33 ins. diam., bears S.33°E., 128½ lks.  
 dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 18 B T.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N.87½°W., 33 lks.  
 dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W C C S 7 and 18 B T.

Land, mountainous. 78.81 chs.  
 Soil, E 53.50 chs, 3d rate; balance stony, 4th rate.  
 Heavily timbered with fir, laurel, cedar, chinquapin,  
 yew and maple. E 53.50 chs.  
 Dense undergrowth of laurel, vine maple, hazel,  
 rhododendron, arrow-wood, thimbleberry, cedar, hemlock,  
 chinquapin and fir. 78.81 chs.
