52.25 A stream, 3 lks. wide, course SW; ascend. +40

54.00 Top of spur, course NE and SW; descend. -60

56.50 A ravine, course E and W; ascend very steeply on rocky land. +800

61.95 A rocky bluff, 60 ft. high.

68.00 Summit of spur, course E and W; descend. -125

75.30 A ravine, course E and W; ascend. +60

76.84 To a point, 19 lks. W of cor. to secs. 12 and 13.

A laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.36 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 64 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W C C S 6 and 7 B T.

Land, mountainous. 79.18 chs.

Soil, 3d rate, E 75.00 chs.; balance, stony, 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, laurel, cedar and maple.
