29.55	A fir, 5 ft. diam., on line marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.	
40.00	Set a stone, 14x8x4 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face; from which A yew, 14 ins. diam., bears S.16 $\frac{1}{4}$ *W., 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.41*E., 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

93.75	A ravine, water in holes, course NE and SW; ascend.	+125
105.00	Intersect the N bdy. of the tp. 1.68 chs. W of the closing cor. to secs. 31 and 32. At point of intersection, set a stone, 12x12x4 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. to secs. 5 and 6, marked C C on S face, with 5 notches on E and 1 notch on W faces; from which A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.54 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks.
