- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 52.50 Ascend steep NW. slope of mountain.
- 66.50 Top of ridge, c SW.
- 80.93 Intersect the E. Bdy. of the township, 23 lks. S. of the cor. to secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is a post, firmly set in the ground, from which
- A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.50\*E., 45 lks. dist.  
Marked T 31 S R 4 W S 30 B T.
- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.32\*E., 41 lks. dist.  
Marked T 31 S R 4 W S 31 B T.
- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.36\*W., 31 lks. dist.  
Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 36 B T.
- A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.54\*W., 31 lks. dist.  
Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 25 B T.

- 40.47 Set a stone 12x12x5 ins., 10 ins. in ground, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on the N. side, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., from which
- A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N., 50 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.35\*E., 24 lks. dist.  
Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.
- 80.93 The cor. to secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
- Land, mountainous and broken.
- Soil, clay, third rate.
- Timber, chiefly fir, cedar and laurel.
- Thick undergrowth of fir, cedar, hazel, willow and maple.
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- Va. 19\*E.
- North, between secs. 25 and 26.
- 4.20 A creek, 3 lks. wide, c W. Steep ascent.
- 16.00 Top of spur, c W. Steep descent.
