A Laurel, 16 ins. diam., bears S.67*E., 29 lks.

Marked T 31 S R 4 W S 7 B T.

A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.11*W., 34 lks.

Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 1 B T.

No tree in Section 12.

Thence, I run

South 89*39'West on true line between sections 1 and 12
with same variation.

40.05 Set a Laurel post, 3 feet long, 3 ins. square, 18 ins.
in ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ s on North side for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
cor., from which

A Laurel, 12 ins. in diam., bears S.35*E., 93 lks.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 41 lks. dis.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ B B T.

80.10 The corner to sections 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, mountainous

Soil, rocky, third rate.

Timber, east Part, dense growth of Fir, cedar, & Laurel.

West part, scattering same.

Thick undergrowth of Fir, Cedar, & Laurel with Hazel

Maple, and arrow-wood, on whole line.

North on Random line between Sections 1 & 2.

0.30 Stage Road, c Nw. & S.85*E.

4.50 Barn West about 100 lks. Steep ascent.

20.00 Top of ridge along West slope, very steep.

31.00 Steep descent.

39.50 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, c W.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Steep Ascent.

76.00 Top of high ridge, c East and West.
