80.00 Set temp. cor. Unable to find any corner or line. I reestablish the same.

80.90 Intersect North boundary of Township, 23 lks. west of cor. to sections 1, 2, 35 and 36, which is a maple post, firmly set in the ground and properly marked, and, from which

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.40\*E., 26 lks. dist.

Marked T 30 S R 5 W S 36 B T.

A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S.40\*E., 29 lks. dist.

Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 2 B T.
