East, on random line between sections 26 and 35.

Steep descent.

14.60 Creek, 5 lks. wide, c N. Steep ascent.

36.00 Top of ridge, c N. Steep descent.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

56.00 Stage Road c, N.20*E., and S.20*W.

57.10 Canyon Creek, 5 lks. wide, c N.20*E. Ascent.

73.50 Top of spur, c NW.

80.60 Intersect N. and S. lines, 70 lks. S. of corner to
secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

Thence I run

South 89*30*W., on a true line between secs. 26 and 35,
with same variation.

40.30 Set a laurel post, 3 ins. square, 3 ft. long, 20 ins. in

11.50 Top of spur, c NE. Ascent.

32.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, c E. Ascent steep.

40.00 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 18 ins. in
ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on West side, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,
