80.00	Set laurel post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 22 ins. in ground, for the cor. to secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, marked T 31 S R 5 W S 22 on NE. S 27 on SE. S 28 on SW. and S 21 on NW. faces with 2 notches on the South and 3 notches on the East edges, from which A laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.55*E., 26 lks. Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 22 B T. A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.30*E., 15 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 27 B T. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.87*W., 62 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 28 B T. A laurel, 15 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 13 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 5 W S 21 B T.
