| 40.29 | Set Laurel Post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 15 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on North face, from which A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.29°W., 26 lks. dis. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T and A Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N.30°E., 6 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. |
